The journey paper is worth **500 points**. You may structure the paper in whatever way you like, but there are a few rules that you must follow. The paper must be typed – single spaced with 1” margins, using a legible 12-point font – and should be AT LEAST 1 page in length. Papers should have a separate cover page with the title, your name, and date. If the paper does not meet all of these criteria, it will automatically lose 100 points.
