Participation: Officers are expected to participate in all BPA activities, attend all chapter meetings, and take part in all officer meetings. Lack of participation is cause for removal from office. Behavior: If there are problems with discipline or if you receive an ASA, you will be placed on officer probation for 2 weeks. If the problems continue you will be removed from office. If you receive an OSS, you will be immediately removed from office. Academics: You must maintain at least a C in your business class. If you do not have at least a C in your class at the end of each week, you will be placed on officer probation for 2 weeks. If your grade does not improve, you will be removed from office. If you do not feel that you can meet ALL of these expectations, please do not run for office. Why do you feel that you should be elected as a BPA Representative?
