The Live Like Sean Foundation raises awareness about hypertrophic cardiomyopathy, a condition where the heart muscle is abnormally thick and can make it difficult for the heart to pump blood. In many cases, those with the condition do not exhibit any symptoms and are unaware they have it. The foundation was started in memory of Sean Sutton, a 22-year-old athlete who passed away in his sleep. Although Sean had annual physical exams when he participated in high school sports, he never had a checkup on his heart. If he had, it might have saved his life. The foundation's goals are to raise awareness about this condition and raise funds so that every athlete participating in school sports receives an echocardiogram and electrocardiogram if they cannot afford it. The foundation partners with local doctors and hospitals to host healthy heart checkups at area high schools and raises funds through several events. The foundation's board has hired you to design materials needed for the coming year.

**Job 1** - Now that the Live Like Sean Foundation has grown bigger, they need a logo. The foundation wants the logo to have a fresh, active appearance and incorporate the heart in some way since the foundation's purpose is to raise awareness of hypertrophic cardiomyopathy. Draw two boxes on an 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper - one 7" x 7" and one 3.5" x 2". Print the logo proportionally within a 7" x 7" box. In the 3.5" x 2" box, determine sizing and placement of the logo as would be for a business card, leaving appropriate space for text including address, email address, phone number and website.

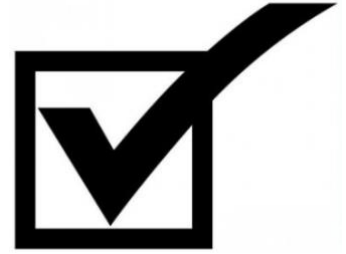
**Job 2** - Create a certificate of appreciation to be given to cardiologists who donate time at the healthy heart checkup clinics. The certificate will be printed on 11" x 8.5" paper. The certificate should include the Live Like Sean logo, a border and the text: Certificate of Appreciation given to, in appreciation for your commitment to raising awareness of hypertrophic cardiomyopathy by participating in the Heart Healthy Checkup Challenge. Under the text "Certificate of Appreciation given to" there should be a 2" blank space so the doctor's name can be inserted. Near the bottom of the certificate there should be two lines parallel to each other, one for a signature and one for the date. Underneath the signature line, type Holly McClain, Chair. Underneath the second line, type the word date. The design should complement the logo and be distinctive, not a generic certificate.

**Job 3** - Design a T-shirt for the Live with Heart 5K race that will be held on April 22, 2023. The T-shirt should include the name of the race, the date and the foundation logo. The foundation's goal is to create awareness of the foundation, so they want an engaging design that will encourage participants to wear the T-shirt beyond the day of the race. Thus, the design should be more than just placing text on a shirt. Your design should fit within an 8" x 8" space. Place your design on the T-shirt and then submit the completed design on an 8.5" x 11" document.
